# • HOW TO MARK THE ANSWERS IN THE OMR SHEET

- 1) Use Black/Blue ball point pen only to write on the Answer sheet.
- 2) Read the questions carefully and decide on the correct answers.
- 3) You have 4 options- a, b, c and d
- 4) Once you decide on the correct option darken the bubble with black/blue ball point pen only.
- 5)An additional blank space(square) given after the 4 options is to be used only in the following cases:

While revising the answers if a student realises that he/she has marked a wrong choice, the student may strike it off, darken the correct circle and write the same (a, b, c, d) in the additional blank space.

In any other cases, the blank space should not be used

- In each section the candidate is expected to attempt only those number of questions as per the instructions. Even if you attempt more questions only the required number (in the order) will be considered for evaluation.
- Save your mobile data/Wi-Fi for the exam.
