Classes 10 & 12 Offline Classes - Guidelines

Dear parents and students,

As informed earlier the offline classes will begin on 1st November 2021.

All the parents and students are asked to read, understand and follow the guidelines given below:

The class 10 and 12 students come to the school at a very crucial time of the year as they are going to appear for the Term I board exam.

 \bigcirc All the parents are expected to give the consent form. The consent form is attached along with this circular. Take a printout of the consent form and bring it duly signed on day 1 itself.

 \bigcirc Any student who has the Covid symptoms like cold, cough, headache, fever, body pain etc. should not come to school. Also, students from containment zone should not come to school.

Gr School buses will NOT be plying. So please arrange your own conveyance.

 \bigcirc Public transport should be avoided as possible. If the public transport is used, please do maintain social distancing while travelling. The students shall also try to avoid contact with other fellow-passengers during their transit.

 $\subset \mathbb{F}$ Parents who come to the campus for student pick up and drop are not expected to gather together or socialize in the campus.

 \bigcirc The parents are reminded not to drop and pick up the students in front of the school gate as it may create unnecessary traffic problem. You may come to the campus. (This provision is given only till the commencement of the full-fledged offline classes)

 $\subset \mathbb{F}$ The students are not expected to wait for the parents in front of the gate. They may stay in the campus from where the parents can pick them up.

 $\subset \mathbb{F}$ Canteen facility will NOT be available in the Campus. Lunch and drinking water should be brought by the student. Common drinking water points will not be open.

 $\subset \mathbb{F}$ All are directed to bring the following: small bottle of sanitizer, extra mask and gloves if necessary.

C All Students shall carry Towel / Handkerchief.

C All Students shall carry their own Pen, Pencil, Study Materials, Text Books, Note Books, Instrument Box, etc., while coming to School. Sharing of the said study materials with fellow students is strictly prohibited.

 \bigcirc Students shall not congregate or get-together in a group in the school campus during interval sessions/ before or after School hours anywhere around the neighborhood, parallel roads & Bus stops.

C Hairstyle: Proper normal haircut and shaven faces compulsory for boys. Girls also should have the proper normal haircut. Exceptions will not be entertained in this regard.

Cr New ID cards will be issued from the school. Students should collect it on payment.

C Students are requested to be in modest dress keeping the decorum of the school and must wear formal dress till the time you are provided with the uniform.

 \bigcirc **Dress code** - The Students should come to school in uniform. Those who have given the order for the new uniform need to collect it on payment. Until you get the uniform, follow the dress code given below:

Girls: Churidar or long top with loose bottom. Short skirts, short tops and frocks are not allowed.

Boys: Formal shirt with pants. T- shirts are not allowed.

Foot wear – Wear black school uniform shoes. Fancy footwear is not allowed.

 \bigcirc Electronic gadgets including mobile are strictly prohibited at school. If required, students will be given assistance from the office to communicate with their parents.

 \bigcirc Students should reach the school and occupy their allotted class rooms following the Covid protocol.

 \bigcirc Boarders: The students who have opted for the boarding facility should undergo the RTPCR test done 72 hours prior to the arrival and submit the report if they are to be allowed to stay.

 \bigcirc Boarders will not be permitted to go outside the school campus under any circumstances. Parents should ensure that they carry with them everything needed for their stay in the boarding.

 \bigcirc Boarders will be allowed to go home only for the Christmas vacation.

 \bigcirc The specific instructions for the boarders will be given from the boarding.

C All Students should strictly follow all the instructions and directives given by the School Management or teachers from time to time.

 $\subset \mathbb{F}$ The specific instructions for the boarders will be given from the boarding. Follow all the Covid protocol and these guidelines for a fruitful and safe Offline classes.
